

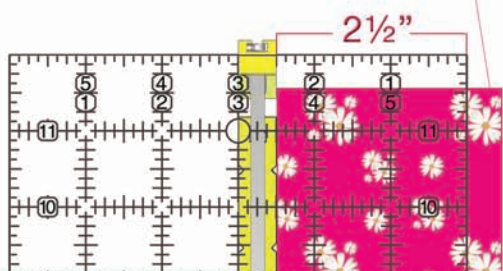

fabric & let the Guide's edge catch

accurate alignment every time.

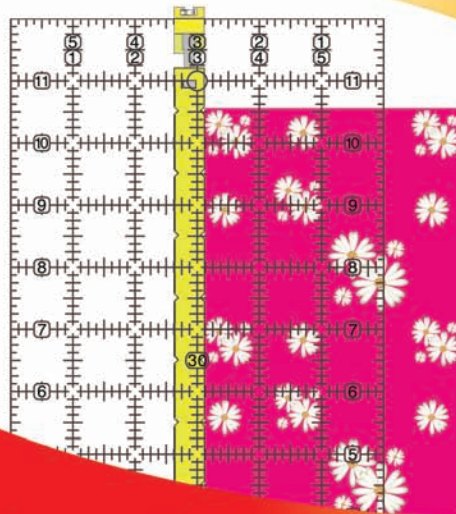

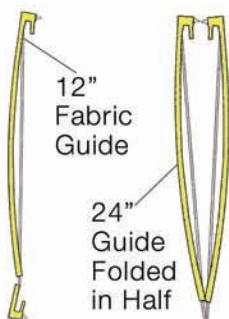
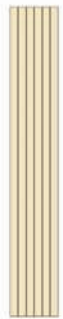

What's in the Kit

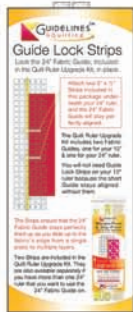
6 Grip Strips on backing paper



12" Fabric Guide

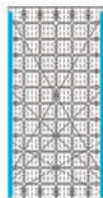
24" Guide Folded in Half

2 Guide Lock Strips with Instructions



First Attach Grip Strips

Peel the clear Grip Strips off the brown backing paper and attach them right up to the edge along the long sides underneath your rulers.



Ruler

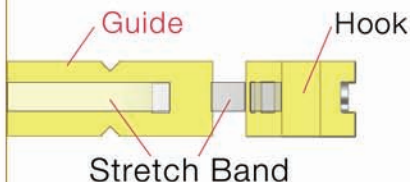
Grip Strips

Put one on each edge of your 12" ruler and two on each edge of your 24" ruler.



Next, Stretch & Clip-On The Fabric Guides

Both the Guide and Stretch Band are very thin to fit under your ruler, but are made of long-lasting, tough materials.



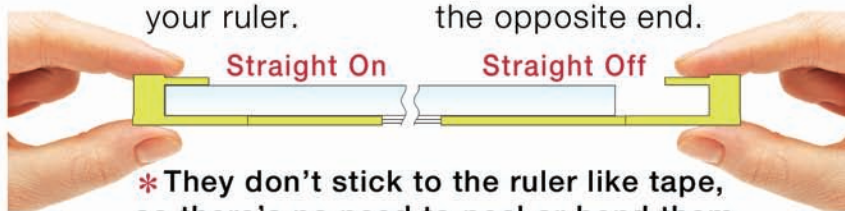

Stretch Band

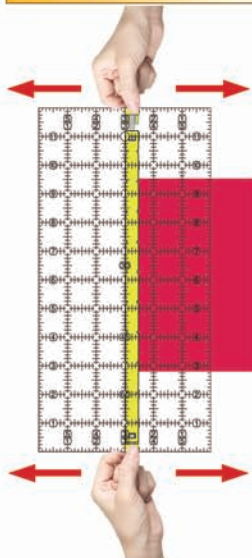
Keep the Fabric Guides Straight.*

1. Clip one hook onto one short end of your ruler.
2. Pull & stretch until you can clip the other hook onto the opposite end.



* They don't stick to the ruler like tape, so there's no need to peel or bend them.

Slide the Fabric Guide by the hooks to the line you want.



Then slide the ruler over the fabric until the Guide's edge catches the fabric's edge. (Left-handers can line up to the left side of the Guide.)

Note: To prevent any wear to the lines & numbers from the Fabric Guide Hooks, you can put a strip of clear tape along the short edges underneath your ruler.

If using Additions, be sure to attach Grip Strips to their outer edges to keep everything level.



Seam Allowance Additions: Plus 2 1/2"



Once You Try Grip Strips, You'll want to slip-proof all your other rulers & templates.
